

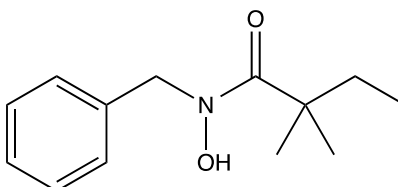

RIPA-56 is a potent ($IC_{50} = 13$ nM, $EC_{50} = 28$ nM for HT-29 cells) and selective inhibitor of Receptor-Interacting Protein 1 (RIP1) kinase with significant metabolic stability ($t_{1/2} = 128$ min human liver microsomal stability assay). RIPA-56 showed excellent kinase selectivity and did not inhibit IDO at 200 μ M. It was able to block the progression of multiple sclerosis in an immune-induced demyelination model.²
