Integrated stress response inhibitor. Potently reverses the effects of initiation factor  $2\alpha$  (eIF2 $\alpha$ ) phosphorylation, IC<sub>50</sub>=5 nM.<sup>1</sup> Enhances spatial and fear-associated learning in mice and enhances cognitive function.<sup>1,2</sup> Mechanism of action involves activation of eiF2 $\beta$ .<sup>3</sup> Suppresses ER stress-induced inflammatory gene expression.<sup>4</sup> Potently attenuates amyloid  $\beta$ -induced neuronal cell death (12.5-25 nM) with no effect on amyloid  $\beta$  production.<sup>5</sup> Reverses hippocampal-dependent cognitive deficits induced by traumatic brain injury in two different injury mouse models.<sup>6</sup>
